The minutes from the June 7th, 2016 meeting were reviewed. Sean made a motion to accept the minutes and Tara seconded it.

Minni reported that the summer swimming program is going well at the town pool. The pool has been very busy with up to 125 people attending a day. There seem to be more families attending this year. About 70 children have attended both the am and pm swimming lessons. There have been no major behavior incidents. Minni has been present more this summer due to having a younger staff. To date, \$4,463.92 has been received for gate entrance fees, lessons, concessions, and season passes. We will likely spend more than budgeted for concessions, but the expense will be covered by sales.

A popcorn and hot dog maker has been purchased for additional concession sales. The fire chief is checking to see if we need a license or permit to sell. We are working for funding to cover the expense of the equipment. It is recommended that we install a smoke detector and purchase a fire extinguisher. The committee authorized the expense.

Minni is going to ask for the spinning playground equipment be removed due to safety concerns. The committee agreed with this change.

The Old Home Day Picnic will be July 23rd from 2-4 pm. The float will have a Future American Olympians theme. There will be a costume parade next week to see who will ride on it. Sean will pull the float.
