Minutes of the Cemetery Trustees – Monday, July 10, 2023

Members present: Cedric Dustin, Pat Heffernan, and Cara Marston

Meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. at the Pittsfield Town Hall.

New Business:

1. Right to Inter certificates – the Trustees signed these right to inter certificates:
 - a. Section E, Lot E-16 – Letendre
 - b. Section E, Lot I-2 – Hackett
2. 2023 Request from Rotary for Balloon Rally – the Rotary asked for the use of Thyng Memorial area of Floral Park for the helicopter landing & Sunday morning yoga. There have been no complaints or concerns received in the past. The Trustees agreed to their use again for this year.
3. Stone damage – Perry Brothers has repaired a few stones from last year, from the previous landscaping contractor. There are still a few more on the list, from the 2022 Balloon Rally and the Brock monument in the old section.
4. Arborist contract – the arborist Caleb Rowell sent over a contract for services for pruning of the Linden trees along the High Street fence and some of the mature maple trees for work that the Trustees had approved last fall. Cara signed the contract.
5. Regulations – the Trustees will look into wording in other towns' regulations that addresses liability for damage done to gravestones.
