**GENERAL DISCUSSION**

The discussion started with organizing the next steps to move forward on the project. Mr. Sansoucy will be producing the final report showing the methods of how to purchase the aqueduct. There were ways discussed about the financial side of the aqueduct. We also discuss ways to approach Nashua and Pennichuck to discuss the purchase of the aqueduct. There is the possibility of going into eminent domain if Nashua refuses to sell. The process of eminent domain will take longer and the cost would be more. There was talk of when to bring in counsel and also the creation of a water district. The committee has decided to create a water district. The logistics of how, when and who has yet to be discuss. The committee will also have public meetings hopefully starting in the fall and have the special town meeting next year. The committee will be using the town maps to create the water district. The water district will involve those that use the service of Pennichuck. Mr. Sansoucy will also put together the financials of the aqueduct, establish a capital improvement plan and show a set of tariffs and rates.
