Minutes October 25, 2018 Meeting

Call to Order: 7:02 PM by Chairman Chris Hill

Meeting Minutes: The minutes of September 27th, 2018 were accepted.

Treasury Report: General Fund = \$459.93

Public Input: None

Old Business:

1. **VRAP proposal account application:** Owen David will be contacted for more information and guidance on how to proceed. No new news at this time.
2. **Request from the master plan committee for a list of conservation properties in town:** More research is being done on where these properties are located and how to develop an updated GIS generated map.
3. **2019 Commission Budget BOS October 9th meeting results.** Chris Hill attended the meeting. The BOS accepted the PCC budget of \$1,000 for the 2019 year.

New Business:

1. **BOS approval of waiver for the BCEP waste disposal from Rocky Ridge Town Forest:** A waiver for disposing debris found on Rocky Ridge Town Forest was accepted and approved by the BOS. This will allow the PCC to dispose of construction debris at BCEP found on the Rocky Ridge Town for no cost. Members of the PCC will volunteer their time and equipment for the cleanup.
2. **Rocky Ridge Cleanup and plan:** Cleanup of Rocky Ridge Town Forest is scheduled to take place Sunday October 28th 2018 at 1 pm. Members of the PCC will meet on site and begin cleaning up a demolished structure found on the property.
3. **NHACC Meeting November 3rd.** Any PCC member is encouraged to go to this meeting if their schedule allows for it. Any registration cost incurred to members would be reimbursed.
4. **DES Wetlands Applications/Notifications (RSA482: A):** The Winsunvale Shores Homeowners Association permit approved by DES was reviewed by the PCC.
5. **Bear Paw Update:** The latest Bear Paw flyer was reviewed by the PCC. An article of local Pittsfield residents (Bachelder family) was featured on pg. 5 of the volume XVIII, issue II Fall 2018. Bear Paw also sent the PCC an inspection notification and report for the Crooked Run / BSA T.L. Storer conservation easement. The monitoring volunteers found no issues during their site visit of the property.
